If you chose to buy a new computer running Windows that is not one of our recommended models, ResNet strongly recommends purchasing a computer that already has a supported operating system installed. Students who request assistance with their personal computers from the ResNet Office must have a supported operating system installed, or they will be required to upgrade their systems. Windows operating system upgrades are available through our Microsoft Campus Agreement, but the upgrade process can take several hours to complete. The length of time varies by computer manufacturer, model, and availability of hardware drivers. Students requesting assistance from the ResNet Office must be present while their computers are being worked on (including upgrades). Not all computers that are sold with an unsupported operating system can be upgraded to a supported operating system.
