The **Anthropology Program** at Saint Mary's College is seeking a broadly trained anthropologist for a position as a Fellow in the Center for Women's InterCultural Leadership starting in August 2008. Saint Mary's College is a Catholic, four-year liberal arts institution for women located in South Bend, Indiana, with an enrollment of approximately 1600 students. The Center for Women's InterCultural Leadership fosters the intercultural knowledge and competence critical to educating the next generation of women leaders, promotes intercultural engagement across the Saint Mary's campus, and connects faculty and students with communities from local to global levels (for more information, see [www.saintmarys.edu/~cwil](http://www.saintmarys.edu/~cwil)). The appointment is for one year with the possibility of renewal for a second year and/or future full-time teaching. Fellow responsibilities include: 1) teaching three courses per year; 2) conducting relevant research; and 3) assisting the department and/or the Center in their programmatic activities.

Applicants will ideally hold a PhD in anthropology by August 2008 and have independent teaching experience. Four-field training is valued. Desired areas of specialization include culture change, globalization, environmental anthropology or cultural ecology, economic anthropology, political anthropology, race and ethnicity, and/or gender. Other topics will also be considered. Geographic area of specialization is open. Teaching responsibilities will include courses that contribute to the General Education program of the college, the required course on ethnographic methods and theory, and elective courses in the area of specialization.

Qualified candidates should submit a letter of interest, CV, and three letters of reference to: Professor Catherine A. Review of applications will begin on February 22, 2008 and will continue until the position is filled.
