

Removing Pop Up Blockers

When you need to disable Pop Up Blockers the following directions for disabling six popular Pop Up Blockers may be helpful. Just remember to turn Pop-Up Blocking on afterwards.

Norton Internet Security

1. Double Click on the Norton Icon(pictured below) in the System Tray
2. Click 'Ad Blocking'
3. Click 'Turn Off'



Google Toolbar:

1. Click on the Google Icon (pictured below) and select 'Options'
2. In the Accessories Section uncheck 'Popup Blocker'



Yahoo Toolbar:

1. Click on the Pop Up Icon pictured below
2. Uncheck 'Enable Pop-Up Blocker'



Internet Explorer on Windows XP Service Pack 2:

1. Click on Tools
2. Choose Pop-up Blocker and click on 'Turn Off Pop-up Blocker'

Netscape/Mozilla Blocker

1. Open the Preferences menu
 - o Using a PC, the Preferences menu is in the Edit menu
 - o Using a Mac, the Preferences menu is in the Netscape/Mozilla menu
2. Open the Privacy and Security Menu

3. Select Pop Up Windows and Uncheck 'Block unrequested pop ups'

Safari Blocker

1. Open the Safari Menu and choose Preferences
2. Open the Security Menu
3. Uncheck 'Block pop up windows'

Windows XP Service Pack 2

Windows XP Service Pack 2 contains a built-in firewall. If you enabled the firewall, you may be prompted with a dialog box, during the Wizard or in a Room, asking you:

"To help protect your computer, Windows Firewall has blocked some features of this program. Do you want to keep blocking this program?

Name: XXXXX. Publisher: blah blah"

If you are confident a particular site is safe, you can choose to "Unblock".
