There are two ways to order a Dell computer through Saint Mary's College:

1. Order the computer through the Shaheen Bookstore. You can contact the Bookstore at 574-284-4719. The computer options available are listed on the opposite side of this flyer. Orders can be placed with Visa, MasterCard, and Discover credit cards. Computers cannot be charged to student accounts. Computers must be ordered prior to 5:00pm EDT on Friday, July 31, and can be picked up at the Bookstore beginning Thursday, August 20. You must present identification and the credit card used for the purchase to pick up the computer.
 2. Order the computer online.

 - b. Click on the *Systems Recommended by Saint Mary's College* link.
 - c. If you wish to purchase our recommended model, click on the *Add to Cart* link to place your order.
 - d. If you wish to purchase a customized version of our recommended model, click on the *Customize* link and customize it to your liking. Click on the *Add to Cart* link to place your order.

What are the differences between ordering a Dell computer from the Bookstore and ordering online?

Ordering from Bookstore

- The specially-priced MP3 and camera options are only available through the Bookstore.
- The computer is available to be picked up when you arrive on campus in August.
- You are charged sales tax on the computer. There are no shipping costs.
- The deadline for ordering is 5:00pm EDT July 31, 2009.

Ordering Online

- The computer is shipped to your home, you have to bring it to campus in August.
 - You are charged sales tax on the computer. Standard shipping is \$29.
 - There is no deadline for ordering.

If you chose to buy a new computer running Windows, ResNet strongly recommends purchasing a computer that already has Windows Vista Business Edition or Windows Vista Ultimate Edition installed (such as our recommended Dell models). ResNet encountered many issues during the past two academic years when students' computers were upgraded from Windows Vista Home Basic Edition or Windows Vista Home Premium Edition to Windows Vista Ultimate Edition to be compatible with our network. New computers that did not have a supported Windows operating system pre-installed that were brought to the ResNet Office during the 2008/2009 academic year averaged more than six hours to complete the upgrade process, and students are required to be present in the ResNet Office while their computers are being upgraded. The length of time varies by computer manufacturer, model, and availability of hardware drivers. Not all computers that are sold with Windows Vista Home Basic Edition or Windows Vista Home Premium Edition installed can be upgraded to Windows Vista Ultimate Edition.
