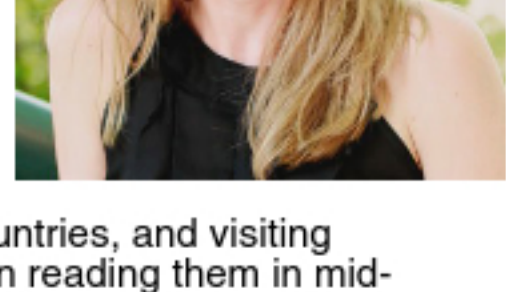

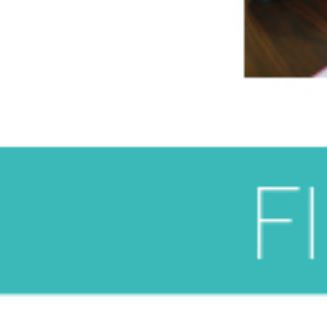

FINANCIAL AID

Saint Mary's now offers every admitted student an academic scholarship!

Saint Mary's College will begin sending 2018-19 financial aid award letters to early decision admitted students in December 2017. Financial aid award letters for regular decision admitted students will begin to be sent in January 2018. We continue to send award letters on a rolling basis once a student has been admitted and we have her FAFSA. The federal school code for Saint Mary's College is 001836.

Any student who is an Indiana 21st Century Scholar should be sure to tell us that by answering this question on the Common Application.

Students with full tuition ROTC or Lilly scholarships also receive a grant from Saint Mary's College which pays the cost of their room, up to the cost of a double, as long as they live on campus. So if a student will have an ROTC or Lilly Scholarship she needs to let us know!

Saint Mary's also offers merit scholarships to every admitted student ranging between \$5,000 - \$25,000.

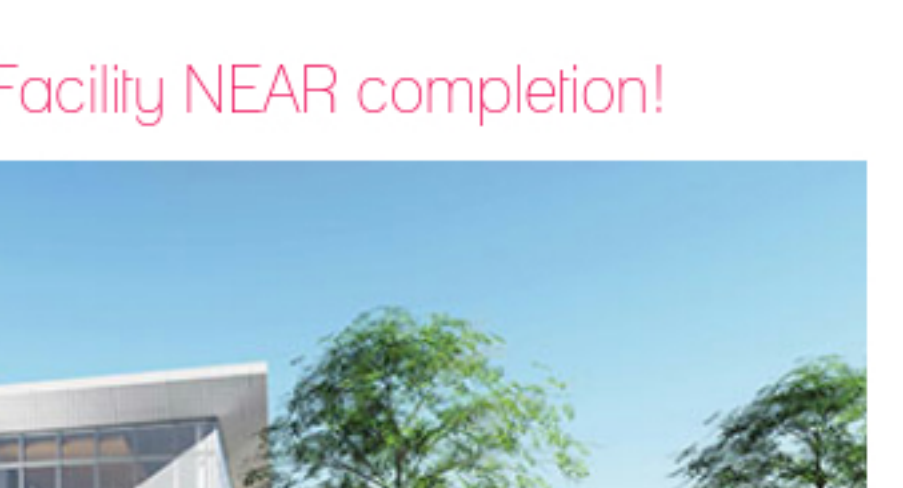

Master's Degree in Autism in the works!

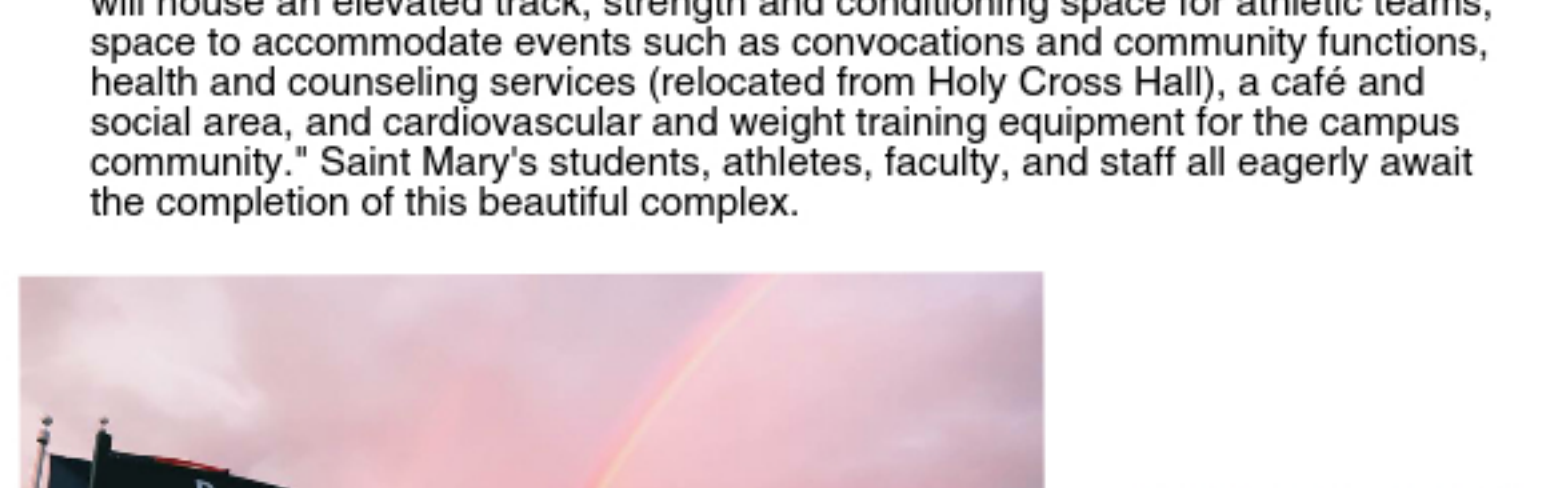
Beginning summer 2019, the College hopes to offer a Master of Autism Studies (MAS). This campus-based program, open to both men and women, will prepare students to respond to the critical needs for understanding and responding meaningfully to autism and people with autism. We believe these needs are best achieved through an interdisciplinary education that strives to understand the lives of people with autism as well as the science of autism spectrum disorder (ASD) and the various forms of intervention that aspire to help people with autism and those who care for them.



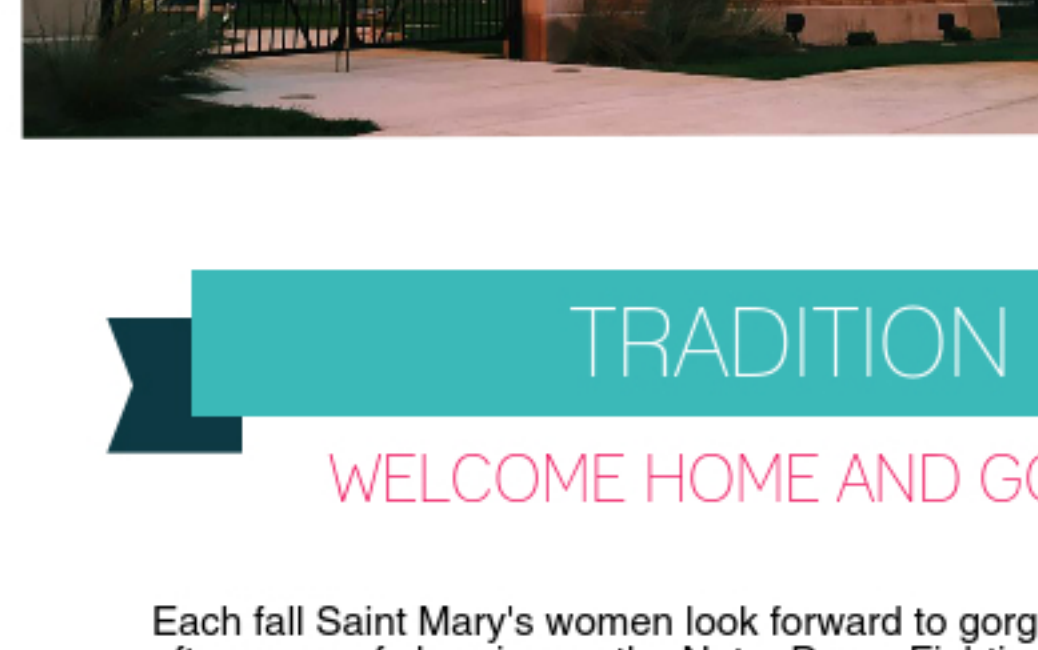

Angela Athletic Facility NEAR completion!



At the recent Saint Mary's College Forum, President Jan Cervelli celebrated the progress of the Angela Athletic Complex with the following, "Saint Mary's new field house opened this week for use by fall athletes, and I'm pleased to report \$25 million-plus in renovations to the Angela Athletic & Wellness Complex will be completed in January 2018, three months ahead of schedule. The complex will house an elevated track, strength and conditioning space for athletes, space to accommodate events such as convocations and community functions, health and counseling services (relocated from Holy Cross Hall), a café and social area, and cardiovascular and weight training equipment for the campus community." Saint Mary's students, athletes, faculty, and staff all eagerly await the completion of this beautiful complex.

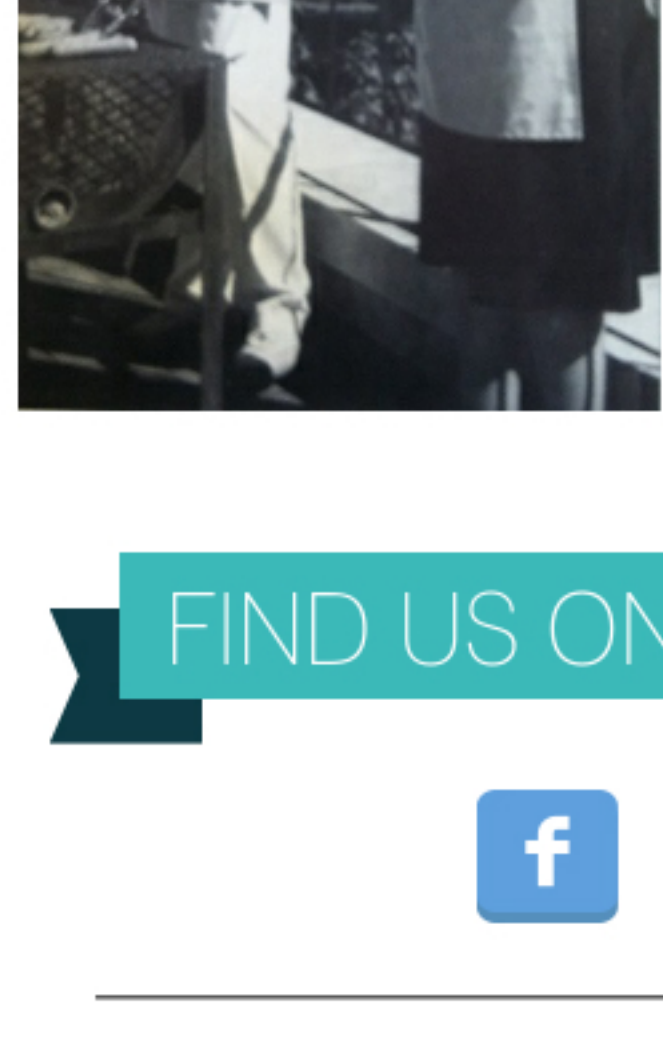

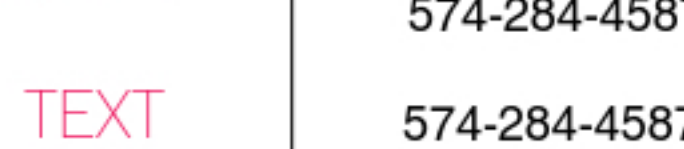
