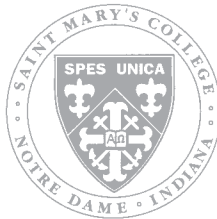

Founded by the Sisters of the Holy Cross in 1844, Saint Mary's College promotes a life of intellectual vigor, aesthetic appreciation, religious sensibility, and social responsibility. Saint Mary's is a Catholic, residential women's college in the liberal arts tradition offering undergraduate degrees and co-educational graduate programs.

A pioneer in the education of women, the College is an academic community where students develop their talents and prepare to make a difference in the world. All members of the College remain faithful to this mission and continually assess their response to the complex needs and challenges of the contemporary world.

## Statement of Philosophy and Purpose

## **Carolyn Y. Woo**

*Doctor of Humanities, Honoris Causa  
Commencement Speaker*

Carolyn Y. Woo is the former chief executive of Catholic Relief Services and the former dean of the University of Notre Dame's Mendoza College of Business. She is now a Distinguished President's Fellow for Global Development at Purdue University, her alma mater.

Born in Hong Kong and educated by the Maryknoll Sisters of Ossining, Carolyn Woo immigrated to the United States to attend Purdue University, where she earned bachelor's, master's, and doctoral degrees.

Becoming a faculty member in Purdue's Krannert School of Management faculty and later the University's associate executive vice president for academic affairs, Carolyn Woo embarked on a transformative career as an innovative leader in higher education and international development. She is an educator and a humanitarian, who embodies the spirit of Saint Mary's College — Carolyn Woo is a woman of action.

Today we recognize the impact that her talent and spirit has had on the world, through the education of young people to become servant leaders like herself, and through the extension of aid to those most in need.

## Sister Margaret “Peggy” O’Neill, SC

*Doctor of Humanities, Honoris Causa*

Sister Peggy O’Neill, SC, established *El Centro Arte Para la Paz*, an educational and cultural center that promotes peace through the arts and spiritual reflection in Suchitoto, El Salvador in 2006, a natural extension of her work in the country that dates back more than three decades.

Serving the Diocese of San Salvador, Sister Peggy O’Neill assisted refugees during El Salvador’s civil war. Currently a faculty member of Santa Clara University’s *Casa de la Solidaridad* in El Salvador, she previously served for 25 years as a theology professor at Iona College and in the Augsburg College Center for Global Education in El Salvador.

A longtime peace activist, Sister Peggy O’Neill’s efforts have been celebrated with the 2008 Peacemaker Award of the Congregation of the Sisters of St. Joseph of Peace and the 2008 *Ciudadana Ilustre* Award, honoring her promotion of social and cultural development in El Salvador.

Today we add our voice in gratitude to Sister Peggy O’Neill, a champion of the cause of peace, who accompanies those caught in the conflicts of the modern world and guides them toward reconciliation and love.

## Academic Regalia

---

The academic dress worn by faculty and administrators originates in the clerical robes worn by students and teachers at the earliest medieval universities. American colleges and universities adopted a code of academic dress based on these robes in 1895 that included regulating the cut and style of the gowns and prescribing hood lining colors to represent the different fields of learning. At Saint Mary's, the president wears blue and white, the official colors of the college.

Most symbolic and informative of the regalia is the hood, which is hung down one's back as a cleric would have worn it when baring one's head in church. All hoods have a velvet border in the color of the degree according to the same system used for the trim of the doctoral gown. In the Middle Ages, academic hoods were lined with wool or fur — a necessity in unheated schools and churches. Today, the interior lining of the hood is generally satin, and is worn to display the colors of the institution from which the wearer received his or her degree.

Saint Mary's graduates wear a black gown and a hood lined with blue and white to denote Saint Mary's College. A colored, velvet border corresponds to the graduate's degree. The colors are as listed:

## Ceremonial Mace

---

The favorite walking stick of Sister Madeleva Wolff, CSC, Saint Mary's third president, is a central part of all College convocations. The Ceremonial Mace leads processions and serves as a symbol of Saint Mary's past and of the path that our graduates will travel.

According to Saint Mary's lore, Sister Madeleva made the walking stick from a dying hawthorn tree on campus. She associated walking sticks with the pilgrim's staff used to traverse the *Camino de Santiago* and with the wood of the cross. Those images remind us of both our need for support on our personal journeys as well as the source of our greatest strength and transcendence.

The Ceremonial Mace, displayed in the Cushwa-Leighton Library when not in use, offers a tangible connection to the founding ideals of the Sisters of the Holy Cross even as it guides us forward.
