BACCALAUREATE LITURGY FRIDAY, MAY 17, 2019 4:00 PM O'LAUGHLIN AUDITORIUM

All are invited to the Baccalaureate Liturgy at 4:00 pm in O'Laughlin Auditorium on Friday, May 17.

Below is information on attire and the procession and recession. Please read carefully.

ATTIRE

Caps, gowns, and hoods are required for the Baccalaureate Liturgy.

PROCESSION

All graduates — both undergraduate and graduate students — will assemble on the 2^{nd} floor of Moreau Hall by **3:45 pm** on Friday, May 17. Please enter directly into Moreau Hall from the entrance by the Moreau Gallery.

Form a double line (to save space). **Unlike for Commencement, the line you are in and the order you are in, do not matter**. Nor does it matter if undergraduates and graduate students are mixed together.

If graduates want to sit next to friends, they will need to be in the same line.

See the diagram below.

Student lines will form in the hallway that connects Moreau Hall with O'Laughlin Auditorium.


THE PROCESSION MOVES AT EXACTLY 4:00 PM.

Marshals will lead graduates single file into O'Laughlin Auditorium by way of the stage.

The entire Left Line will go first, followed by the Right Line. Both lines will go down the steps, Stage Left, into the auditorium. (Stage Left is the right side of the auditorium, if one is facing the stage.)

See the green arrows in diagram below.

The Marshals will seat graduates in O'Laughlin Auditorium. Please enter the row from right to left, and walk down the row as far as possible. Graduates remain standing for the entrance song of the Mass. Instructions will be given during the Liturgy about the reception of Communion.



RECESSION

At the end of the Liturgy, Marshals will lead rows out to the Lobby of O'Laughlin Auditorium.

All will exit to their left (see red arrows in the diagram), and proceed up the left aisle.

It's last in, first out: the Liturgical party will be first out, followed by the Stage Party. Then graduates in the 4^{th} row back will exit, followed by the 3^{rd} row back, and so on.
