

## SAINT MARY'S COLLEGE - PARKING GUIDELINES AND INFORMATION

We are pleased to offer our guests parking for the NHL Winter Classic!

We offer a Game Day, Pay-to-Park option of \$25 per parking place. Our athletic staff will provide you with appropriate direction and guidance regarding parking as well as answering your questions about our campus.

As our guests, we ask that you follow these guidelines:

- Parking begins at approximately 9:00 a.m.
- Our parking spaces range from lighted paved parking lot and, weather permitting, unlighted grass parking.
- Small group tailgating is permitted pre-game on our campus.
- Guests are asked to vacate the lots not later than 4 hours after the conclusion of the game.
- All trash and other waste must be placed in the receptacles provided by Saint Mary's College.
- We ask that our guests comply with directives from our parking attendants and our Security personnel.
- Each vehicle is permitted one parking space.
- Prohibited items: Deep fryers, Drones, Kegs, and Open flames (i.e. fire pits)
- **Understand that you Park At Your Own Risk- Saint Mary's College is Not Responsible For Damage, Theft or Injury.**

### SHUTTLE SERVICE TO AND FROM THE GAME:

As a thank you for parking with us, we provide a *FREE* shuttle option to the campus of Notre Dame. We have contracted two, 56-passenger Royal Excursion buses. The buses will have a "Saint Mary's Shuttle" label in the window. Look for it! There will be a lot of buses especially on the return.

Our pre-game shuttle runs in a continuous loop between our two pick-up points: Spes Unica Hall and Madeleva Bus stop to the Eck Visitors Center (next to the ND Bookstore) on Notre Dame's campus beginning at 10 am.

Postgame shuttles will begin at 3:30 and run continuously until 5:30. The return shuttle will pick-up at the same location as the drop-off, the Notre Dame's Eck Visitors Center. Our campus drop-off points are the same as our on-campus pick-up points.

WALKING DIRECTIONS FROM SAINT MARY'S COLLEGE TO THE STADIUM: Proceed to the main/south entrance of Saint Mary's College. Cross to Notre Dame's campus at the stoplight (Saint Mary's Road). Just after the cemetery, continue on Saint Mary's road as it veers right. This road will lead you to the Grotto and the Basilica. Continue walking toward the center of campus – follow the crowds and you cannot miss the stadium. Link to interactive Notre Dame campus map: <http://map.nd.edu>

RESTROOMS: An on-campus restroom will only be available pre-game from 9 am – 1 pm at Dalloways Clubhouse. Postgame, there **will not** be any restrooms open on campus.

EXITING CAMPUS: You will be directed to turn south (right) to exit campus. Turn right onto Angela Blvd (less than a mile south). Take Angela Blvd to through the stop light across the bridge and take the roundabout to the right onto Riverside Dr. (less than a mile). You will take Riverside Dr approximately 3 miles up to Cleveland Rd. Turn left and follow signs to Toll Road entrance ramp 72. Or turn right onto Cleveland to head east or to get back on 31/933.
