## Proof of Citizenship Verification



Your citizenship could not be confirmed by the Social Security Administration or the Department of Homeland Security. In order to receive federal financial aid, you must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident/eligible noncitizen. To provide your proof of citizenship, please follow the steps below and complete the form.

The following items are accepted as proof of citizenship:

- Citizen not born in United States/Noncitizen National
  - U.S. Passport
  - U.S. Passport Card
  - Certificate of Citizenship
  - Certification of Birth Abroad
  - Certificate of Naturalization
- Permanent Resident/Other Eligible Noncitizen
  - I-94 Arrival-Departure Record
  - Form CBP I-94A
  - United States Travel Document (front cover)
  - Machine Readable Immigrant Visa
  - Alien Registration Receipt Card I-151 (front and back)
  - Resident Alien Card I-551 (front only)
  - Conditional Resident Alien Card (front and back)
  - Permanent Resident Card I-551 (front for older versions, front and back for current versions)

If you are unable to appear in person at the Financial Aid Office of Saint Mary's College with the original documentation, then you must:

- 1) Sign the following statement in the presence of a Notary and,
- 2) Send this signed and notarized form back to the Financial Aid Office at Saint Mary's College along with a copy of the valid government-issued photo identification which was provided to the Notary.
