Study Abroad Guide

If a student begins the Music major in their first semester, they may go abroad in the spring semester of their sophomore year if they have completed the 3-semester Music Theory sequence, or the spring semester of their junior year. If they don't start the Music major until their sophomore year, they may go abroad in the spring semester of their junior year, if they have completed the 3-semester Music Theory sequence. It is important that a Music major completes this 3-semester sequence before they go abroad.

Music Education majors really can't go anywhere for a full year, or they will not graduate on time. Students in this major may go abroad for a semester, but it requires careful planning with the Music Education advisor, as none of the study abroad programs fulfill Music course requirements for the Music major.
