Nursing Department Study Abroad Plan

The schedule for nursing majors is tight with many required and sequenced courses in order to prepare for the state licensure in nursing. However, it is possible to study abroad as a nursing major! Two great options are:

- 1) Students may study abroad during the fall semester of sophomore year. Those who intend to study abroad in the fall must take BIO 224 Introduction to Pathophysiology and BIO 216 Introduction to Microbiology in the summer prior to departure. These summer courses are intended for study abroad students, students needing to retake a course, and students intending to apply to the MSN program.
- 2) Participate in a summer study abroad program. Summer study abroad options offer elective and, in some cases, Sophia credits.

(There could be additional spring break options that would work for Nursing majors.)

At this time, there are **no Nursing major courses offered abroad**. However, there are **many Sophia courses** that students can take that will allow them to stay on track with their overall graduation requirements.
