- Complete the EDUC 201 field experience with a satisfactory evaluation
- Demonstrate basic skills competency (Pass Praxis I or appropriate SAT/ACT scores)

Praxis I: Reading – 176, Math – 175, Writing – 172 or Reading, Writing, Math Composite Score - 527 SAT - Critical Reading and Math -1100 ACT – Math, Reading, Grammar, and Science – 24

- Submit an application to the department
- Submit two acceptable dispositions evaluations
