

# Education Department Alumnae Survey May 2007 and 2011 Graduates Overall Summary

In the spring of 2012, Saint Mary's College administered a survey to alumnae who had graduated one (2011 grads) and five (2007 grads) years out. The College Education Department collaborated with the Office of Institutional Research and Assessment to include a set of questions specific to alumnae who graduated with an Elementary Education major or Secondary Education minor. These alumnae were first sent an invitation to participate in the online version of this survey. A print mailing was then sent to those alumnae without email addresses and those who did not respond to the initial email survey. Of the 101 alumnae who were surveyed, either through email, paper, or a combination, 51 responded for a response rate of 50.5%.
