


One and Five-Years-Out Survey of Graduates <u>May 2009 and May 2013 Graduates</u> <u>Overall Executive Summary</u>

In the Spring of 2014, Saint Mary's College administered a survey to alumnae who had graduated the previous year (May 2013) and five-years prior (May 2009). These alumnae were first sent an invitation to participate in the online version of this survey. A print mailing was then sent to those alumnae without email addresses and/or those who did not respond to the initial email survey. Of the 371 May 2013 graduates surveyed, 170 responded for a response rate of 45.8%. Of the 309 total May 2009 graduates surveyed, 146 surveys were completed for a response rate of 47.2%. The goal of these annual employment surveys is to better understand the outcomes of our graduates.


Employment and Graduate School Attendance

May 2013 Graduates (One-Year-Out)




One-Year Out, 93% of May 2013 graduates are either employed or enrolled in graduate or professional school.

May 2009 Graduates (Five-Years-Out)



• Five-Years Out, 92% of May 2009 graduates are either employed or enrolled in graduate or professional school.

Percentage of Graduates Currently Employed



• Graduates five-years out are more likely to be employed full-time largely due to the prevalence of students one year out currently enrolled in graduate/professional school also holding part-time jobs.





• In 2010, 2.2% of May 2009 graduates reported earning \$60,000 or more. Five-years later, the percentage of May 2009 graduates reporting earning \$60,000 or more increased to nearly a quarter of graduates or ten times as many graduates.

Degree Pursued of Those Enrolled or Completed Graduate/Professional School




Saint Mary's College Prepared Me Well For: (% Well or Very Well)



• More than 8 in 10 graduates indicate that Saint Mary's prepared them well for their current job and/or graduate/professional school.


Educational and Professional Fulfillment

• More than 80% of May 2013 graduates believe that Saint Mary's helped them discover their gifts and passions, determine what their world needs from them and/or make a difference in the world. Slightly fewer May 2009 graduates reported this high level of contribution but still, more than two-thirds reported the College helped them in these areas.
