

## Institutional Research Update (August 2015)

This month's update examines first-year students who entered Saint Mary's College between the fall of 2010 and the fall of 2014. This data covers the five most recent cohorts of Saint Mary's students. Specifically, this report focuses on Indiana residents whom, according to the most recent census (Fall 2014), represent 26% of undergraduate students. Of those Indiana residents, approximately 46% come to Saint Mary's from St. Joseph County, while the next most represented county is Lake which accounts for 9% of first-time students over that time period. The table below lists the top ten most represented counties within Indiana in descending order.



While St. Joseph County is well represented at Saint Mary's College, over 50% of firsttime students from Indiana are from either St. Joseph or Elkhart counties. The next most represented region in Indiana is from the northwest. The counties of Lake, Porter, and LaPorte account for 16.0% of first-time Indiana students over the five-year period. The table below identifies four different regions in Indiana and how they are numerically represented among first-year students from Indiana at Saint Mary's College.

The table below shows a geographical representation of the distributions of first-year students who come from Indiana by zip code. The larger the dot indicates a higher representation from that particular zip code. As the image below clearly shows the 46530 zip code, which lies in the northeastern corner of St. Joseph County, as the most represented among Indiana first-year students at Saint Mary's.
