


Institutional Research Update (May 2015)

This month's update takes a snapshot of the most recent Saint Mary's graduates from academic year 2014-15 (those graduating August 2014, December 2014, and May 2015). Specifically, the update looks at the degrees and majors most commonly earned, racial/socioeconomic/geographic diversity, time to degree, and plans following graduation. A total of 329 students graduated in academic year 2014-15 earning 332 degrees and completing 382 majors. The vast majority earned their degree in four-years. Nursing was the most frequently completed major with 16% of graduates earning the major. Just over half of graduates completed a minor and 16% completed two majors. Graduates represent diverse backgrounds as 13% were students of color, 21% first generation, 25% Pell recipients, and 30% coming from states other than Indiana, Illinois, Michigan or Ohio. By the time the 2014-15 students graduated, the majority (56%) had already accepted or been offered employment, admission into graduate school or were pursuing voluntary service.






