

SUSANNE KAHL MANGAN FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP FOR JUNIOR/SENIOR EDUCATION STUDENTS

The Susanne Kahl Mangan Foundation Scholarship is an annual tuition award of \$3,000 given each year to an eligible junior or senior Education Major at Saint Mary's College. **The annual application deadline is April 20.**

Eligibility criteria

- ◆ Rising Junior or Senior Education major at Saint Mary's College, Notre Dame, Indiana
- ◆ Minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0
- ◆ Certified academic transcript
- ◆ Completed application form from the Foundation
- ◆ Financial need is a consideration but not a requirement

The Scholarship is provided by the Susanne Kahl Mangan Foundation, an independent organization created after Susie passed away July 5, 1997. Contributors to the Foundation's fund include family, friends and even those who never knew Susie - all of whom were touched by Susie in life and in dying. The Principals of the Foundation are solely responsible in determining the recipient of the annual award. The Foundation will work with the Saint Mary's College Office of Financial Aid in determining the financial need of a current Saint Mary's College student applicant. BACKGROUND

On July 5, 1997, Susanne Kahl Mangan was married in the Holy Spirit Chapel at Saint Mary's College to Sean Kennedy Mangan, a graduate of the University of Notre Dame. However, Susie's happiest day turned out to be her last. As Susie and Sean left their reception and made their way to a nearby bed & breakfast, Susie collapsed in her husband's arms and died - a victim of a congenital heart condition known as cardiomyopathy.

Susie was a 1995 graduate of Saint Mary's College and received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Elementary Education. Her lifelong aspiration was to teach children, and she herself was a consummately dedicated student, studying long hours to prepare herself to be a professional educator.

Susie's greatest moments in college came during her sophomore year, when she studied abroad in the Saint Mary's Rome Program. Possessed with a magnetic personality and an infectious love of life, her smile and laugh were readily given and engaging. Committed to the ideal that those with more should serve those with less, her adventuresome spirit took her to Alaska after graduation in pursuit of her long-held dream to teach.

In August 1995, she was hired as the only first grade teacher in the village of Hydaburg, a remote Native American village of 400 people located on Prince of Wales Island in southeastern Alaska. Susie spent two years in Hydaburg, teaching, befriending and guiding children and even other villagers. Those who knew and loved her are forever changed by her presence in their lives. To carry on her memory, it is the Foundation's wish that her life continues to inspire other teachers to use their gifts in areas where they are most needed.
