- · Common intellectual experiences, such as a common core
- Learning communities
- Writing-intensive courses
- Collaborative assignments and projects
- Undergraduate research
- Diversity and global learning
- · Service learning and community-based learning
- Internships
- Capstone courses and projects

Presentations on other SoTL topics will be considered, but preference will be on empirical research on High Impact Practices.

Submissions may follow one of the following formats.

- · Brief presentation: 20 minutes, as part of a panel of 2-3 presenters
- Full presentation: 30 minutes with 20 minute Q&A period
- Poster board presentation

To submit a proposal, please send the following information for each presentation:

- Presentation format
- Title
- Short abstract (2-3 sentences for promotional materials)
- Presentation summary that discusses how the research relates to the scholarship of teaching and learning and the conference theme (500-1000 words)

Proposals should also include for each presenter:

- Name
- Institution or Affiliation
- Position/Title

- Mailing and e-mail addresses
- Phone number
- Brief biographical information
