Take-Aways:

- All Cooperative Teacher summative scores were significantly higher than the formative scores. Summative scores from the College Supervisor were also higher than formative scores from the cooperative teachers.
- There were not significant differences in scores between Cooperative Teacher and College Supervisor summative scores
- Only one significant difference was found when comparing scores from Elementary and Secondary Education students. Elementary Education students earned significantly higher scores on the standard 7 summative assessment from the College Supervisor.
