Populations-at-risk: Field practicum placements should give students the opportunities to identify the patterns, dynamics, and consequences of oppression, economic deprivation and discrimination against populations-at-risk including people of color, women, gay men and lesbian women, and populations distinguished by age, ethnicity, culture, class, religion, and physical and mental ability.

E.) Human Behavior and the Social Environment: Field practicum placements should give students opportunities to apply human behavior and the social environment theory to generalist social work practice in their field practicum setting.

Social Welfare Policy and Services: Field practicum placements should give students opportunities to identify social welfare history and patterns of providing services in order to develop the generalist social work practice skills necessary in identifying the role of social policy in assisting or deterring them from improving their quality of life.
