ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

To embark on your journey towards an advanced degree in Speech Language Pathology, follow these steps:

Eligibility Criteria

Candidates must possess a Bachelor's degree in Communication Sciences and Disorders or a related field from a regionally accredited college or university, or an international equivalent.

Cumulative GPA

A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 in your undergraduate coursework is typically expected.

Application Submission

Complete the CSDCAS application to ensure a smooth admissions process.

Official Transcripts

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Provide official transcripts from every college or university you have attended. These should be mailed directly to CSDCAS.

Letters of Recommendation

Submit three letters of recommendation from individuals who are familiar with your academic and professional abilities. These letters should emphasize your potential for success in the program.

Personal Statement

Craft a personal statement that details your motivations for pursuing an advanced degree in speech language pathology. Share your professional objectives and explain how Saint Mary's College aligns with your personal and career aspirations.
